### ACE of Birmingham: App Registration & Payment Authorization

#### Website Registration and Payment Authorization

ACE of Birmingham athletes must be registered in Jackrabbit, our online system, prior to Athlete Evaluations. Jackrabbit is used for scheduling classes and making account payments. A credit/debit card is required for registration. Please use the following steps to complete online registration:

- Visit the App Store and download our app, ACE Cheer Birmingham
- Click 'My Account'
- Complete the registration process and put a card on file.

#### Monthly Payments

ACE monthly payment plans have been arranged to distribute the costs associated with competitive cheerleading (e.g., competition fees, etc.) in an affordable manner. In order to keep these fees at a lower cost, ACE of Birmingham distributes these expenses during the course of the entire season. Timely payments are also expected from all ACE of Birmingham families, parents, and athletes.

- Monthly fees are posted to athlete accounts at the end of the prior month.
- *(Example: July fees are billed in June.)*
- Monthly payments are automatically charged on the 25<sup>th</sup> of the prior month.
- *(Example: July Fees are charged on June 25<sup>th</sup>.)*
- Accounts not paid by the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month will be assessed a \$25 late fee.
